DESCRIPTION OF ACCESS CONTROL VOLUNTEER DUTIES

- Responsible for controlling access inside the competition venue, which includes:
 - o Checking participant credentials to ensure compliance with venue zone access.
 - o Monitoring areas around the venue, "the eyes and ears of the meet operations."
 - Reporting any incidents to appropriate LOC or venue staff.
- Provide directions and support to athletes, coaches, staff and guests navigating the venue.
- Smile! As a volunteer our job is to be a pleasant and welcoming presence at the event.

VOLUNTEER CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT

Upon arrival at the Natatorium at IU Indianapolis, all Access Control volunteers will:

- Report directly to the Volunteer Services Desk located in the Natatorium Pro Shop at the
 bottom of the NE deck entry stairs. You will receive your volunteer event credentials and meet
 your Access Control on-duty Committee Chair. Your Committee Chair will provide an overview
 of the venue access points that will need to monitored and take you to one of these locations.
- At the completion of a shift, volunteers should remain at their station until released by your Access Control Committee Chair. Volunteers will go back to the Volunteer Services Desk to check out, return credentials and receive a voucher for free parking at the Riverwalk Garage.

COMMITTEE SHIFT TIMES & MEALS

Volunteers receive a meal with each shift worked. In general, the following meals will be provided:

- Shift 2 11:30AM-4:00PM (6/1-6/2) Lunch

- Shifts 3 & 4 3:30PM-8:30PM (6/1-6/2) Dinner
 2:30PM-6:30PM (6/3-6/7) Dinner
 6:00PM-10:00PM (6/3-6/7) Dinner

Volunteer meals will be served in Hospitality Room at the south end of the Natatorium behind the diving towers. Committee Chairs will release volunteers at designated break times during each shift to eat. Volunteers with special dietary needs are welcome to pack their meals; refrigeration is available.

ADDITIONAL COMMITTEE INFORMATION

- Cell phones are <u>NOT</u> allowed during scheduled volunteer times unless used for communication to Access Control Committee Chairs.
- Volunteer shirts will be provided. Please wear **black pants/capris** and comfortable closed-toed shoes. This role may require significant standing and/or walking.
- There will be no place for volunteers to securely store personal items. Please do not bring any personal belongings that cannot be kept on your person. Waist packs and small over-the-shoulder bags are permitted to hold any items that you need.
- Volunteer parking is located on floors 5 & 6 of the Riverwalk Garage. The Riverwalk Garage is adjacent to the Natatorium Sports Garage and connected by a bridge on the 3rd floor. Volunteers need to pull a ticket upon entry and proceed to floors 5 or 6 to park. You will need the ticket that was pulled upon entry to exit the garage after your shift, so please keep ticket in a secure location. You will be given a voucher at the end of your shift for free parking.
